

NP-USA SIGNS MERGER AGREEMENT WITH DUNN-EDWARDS

Teaneck, NJ, December 22, 2016— Nippon Paint (USA) Inc. (NP-USA®) and its parent company, Nippon Paint Holdings Co., Ltd. (Nippon Paint) of Osaka, Japan (TYO 4612), announced today that they have entered into a merger agreement with Dunn-Edwards Corporation, one of the United States' largest independent manufacturers of architectural, industrial and high performance paints. Terms of the deal were not disclosed.

The transaction is expected to be finalized in early March 2017 after which Dunn-Edwards will become a wholly owned subsidiary of Nippon Paint (USA) Inc.
